

Introduction to **JUDAISM**

Twenty Tuesday evenings, 7:15-9:15, Beginning October 11, 2011

We will study the fundamentals of Jewish thought and practice. Topics include Jewish Holidays, the Shabbat, prayer, theology, Mitzvot, Israel and life cycle events. We will engage with the texts and observances that are the foundation of Jewish life in the home and Synagogue. Designed for individuals and couples who seek a deeper connection to Judaism, for parents who want to enrich their Jewish parenting, and for those who are considering conversion to Judaism.

Four sessions of this course, focusing on central Jewish beliefs, will be led by Rabbi Weintraub.

Jason Gitlin is a Rabbinical student at the Jewish Theological Seminary. He holds an M.A, in Near Eastern Studies from NYU, and has worked a journalist, interfaith affair specialist, and as a Fellow in the Muehlstein Institute for Jewish Professional Leadership.”
