Baby Sitting: Ages 0 - 5, 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM

Mini Minyan: Ages 2 - 4 (and at least one parent), 11:15 AM to Noon

Junior Congregation: K - 2nd Grades, 11:15 AM to 12:15 PM

KC Minyan: 3rd - 6th Grades, 11:15 AM to 12:30 PM

Camp Shabbat: Ages 4 - 12, 10:00 AM and after Family Services until 1:00 PM

If children do not wish to attend these services, parents are expected to keep them engaged and happy.

After Family Services children may join their parents in the Sanctuary or go to a classroom, which has grown-up supervision.

Parents are invited to attend all Family Services. No food is allowed outside of the Kiddush area.
