Prayerbook Hebrew Reading/Modern Hebrew conversation Level II

This course is a continuation of the Hebrew reading course offered last winter (January –March 2011) at Kane Street Synagogue by Andreea Adereth. However, anyone with a reading knowledge of Hebrew may join in. We will continue to gain fluency in reading the Shabbat prayers, and use knowledge of the words of prayer as an entrée into forming simple conversations in modern Hebrew.
